We can help prevent delays!

- ALL new single-family residential and duplex construction in unincorporated Marion County requires connection to the Marion County Utilities water and wastewater system if either property line is within 400 feet of the system.
- Water main extensions are the responsibility of the builder or developer.
- Capital charges and all utility fees are due before a building permit can be issued.
- Checking to see if a connection is required before applying for a permit can prevent costly delays.

Water and wastewater requirements pertain to single-family residential and duplex construction within a connection distance of 400 feet from the nearest property boundary.
