

Program Summary

Marion County Local Mitigation Strategy | *December 21, 2018*

1. Marion County Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS)
 - a. Marion County has adopted a Local Mitigation Strategy in accordance with the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000.
 - b. Chapter 44 CFR Sections 201 & 206 provide that local jurisdiction(s) must review and revise the local mitigation plan to reflect changes in development, progress in local mitigation efforts, and changes in priorities, and update the local mitigation plan a minimum of every five (5) years in order to continue to be eligible for Federal Hazard Mitigation Funds under the Federal Emergency Management Agency (“FEMA”).
 - c. The LMS document was updated in 2015. The LMS Plan Five Year Update was approved by the Marion County Board of County Commissioners on April 5, 2016 by Resolution No. 16-R-115. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) granted formal approval of the document on April 21, 2016. It will expire on May 19, 2021. As an approved participating jurisdiction, the County is an eligible applicant for the following mitigation programs administered by FEMA: Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), Pre-disaster Mitigation (PDM), and Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA).
 - d. The LMS is coordinated by the Marion County Growth Services Department, 2710 E. Silver Springs Blvd., Ocala, FL 34470. Staff contact is Juan Castillo, Planner II.
 - e. In accordance with the LMS by-laws, the strategy is guided by a local working group led by a Steering Committee containing representatives from Marion County, incorporated municipalities, key businesses, interest groups, and citizens.

Subject: Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS) and Mitigation Project List

It is time to update our *LMS Mitigation Project List*. The *Project List* identifies potential mitigation projects that reduce the community's vulnerability to hazardous events. Possible projects can include methods to prepare for events, endure events, respond to events, and recover from events. In order to qualify for funding through certain state and federal programs, a project must be included on the List. The *Project List* is overseen by the LMS Steering Committee, and a Mitigation Project Application must be submitted for review, scoring, and ranking by the Steering Committee to be included on the *Project List*. Once approved, a Project may remain on the *Project List* for up to 5 years.

Two deadlines are established each year. The first deadline is June 25, 2018. The second deadline is November 1, 2018. The Steering Committee will score and rank the applications at the next available meeting (date TBA).

To be considered in the first review cycle, all project applications must be submitted no later than June 25, 2018 to:

The Steering Committee has established two requirements for all projects:

- 1) To remain on the *Project List* each year, the project’s applicant must appear in person before the Steering Committee at least once in the calendar year to provide a project status update to the Committee.
- 2) After 5 years, a project will expire from the *Project List*; however a new Project Application may be submitted for that same project to update the project data and renew the project.

The following projects will fully expire from the list at the end of 2018 if a new/update project application is not submitted before end of the calendar year. Please be sure to review the current LMS Project List to identify projects in your jurisdiction and submit an updated project application as necessary:
