 - We assist with case management, budget counseling, job searching, rental and utility arrears, and returning to a stable home environment

Veteran's Village (The Ritz)

- Transitional program for veterans who qualify.
 - 50 beds (47 for males, 3 for females)
 - Operated through a VA GPD-Grant per Diem program
 - The Ritz offer NA and AA meetings, monthly health Seminar, Wellness Recovery Action Plan amongst other programs to their residents.
 - Each resident has an Independent Living Counselor to work towards self-sufficiency.

Items required for program entry

- Proof of veteran status (DD Form 214, VA Healthcare card, HINQ, etc.)
- Proof of income is required as this is an income-based program
 - Last 3 month's pay stubs, current benefit award letter, etc.)
- Photo Identification card
- Social Security Card for everyone in the household
- For homeless prevention, a late notice is required
