CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting began at 3:00 pm. in the Growth Service Training Room.

INTRODUCTIONS:

- Commissioner Curry open the meeting up by welcoming everyone to the committee and touch on the purpose of the committee and why we are here.
- The Litter task Force is made up of 7 appointees which serve as voting member.

5 appointed from Commissioners and 1 from school board and 1 from Sheriff Dept. The rest of the committee is supporting members.

- This task force is more than getting the Litter picked up on the roadways. This task force is to help change the heart and the mind set of our community.
- Towards end of meeting Committee will break into sub groups to decide meeting locations and times. Public is welcome to all meetings.

- Groups discussed Don't Mess with Texas and how they reduced the Litter by 70% with this campaign.
- 1.3 Million pounds of Litter was picked up in Marion County in 2020. Marion County Litter program spent \$933,616 in FY 2020.
- The group will provide a massive effort to help get our message out.
- Commissioner Curry pointed out to the Committee the primary source of revenue for litter is from Solid Waste \$87.00 Waste Assessment.
- Bobbi Perez provide information on the Litter Survey that was posted on Facebook and spoke about the new Litter Website that is being developed.

DISCUSSION OF FLORIDA SUNSHINE LAW:

County Attorney Minter advised that all meetings of the Work Group must comply with the requirements of the Florida Sunshine Law. He addressed 3 of the main requirements, as follows: 1) all meetings must be held in public; 2) all meeting must be properly noticed; and 3) minutes must be taken and timely transcribed for all meetings. Mr. Minter stated that a member could not discuss, email or text issues of the Work Group with fellow members outside of a noticed meeting. Russell Ward, Assistant County Attorney will be attending as many of the meetings as possible to ensure legal guidance is available.

- Introduced herself and informed the group that she is the Chair for the Committee.
- Nov 1st the Task Force will meet as a group and discuss where the Committees are at so far.
- The end goal date for the Task Force will be on April 4th for the Committee to review before it is presented to the Commission.
