MINING SPECIAL USE PERMIT**

The following items must be completed and submitted to the Zoning Department.

- ___ **1. Application, signed with attached check in proper amount.**
- ___ **2. Copy of deed(s).**
- ___ **3. Copy of legal description of property.**
- ___ **4. Copy of Notice of Intent to Mine.**
- ___ **5. Copy of Florida Department of Environmental Protection Permits.**
- ___ **6. Copy of Management and Storage of Surface Water Permit from appropriate water management district of Florida Department of Environmental Protection.**
- ___ **7. Copy of Consumptive Use Permit from appropriate water management district.**
- ___ **8. Copy of U.S. Army Corps of Engineers permits if wetlands are affected.**
- ___ **9. Written findings of fact which will demonstrate that the proposed use will not adversely affect the public interest, the proposed use is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan, and the proposed use is compatible with land uses in the surrounding area. See Section 4.6, Special Use Permit Submittal Procedures, and Findings, of the application package.**
- ___ **10. Twenty copies of a concept plan prepared in accordance with Article 9, Marion County Land Development Code.**
- ___ **11. KARST Sensitivity Study- twenty copies.**
- ___ **12. Modified Environmental Assessment Study- twenty copies.**
- ___ **13. Major Site Plan including studies and analysis required by Article 6.4, Springs Protection Overlay Zone (20 copies). Separate application of the Major Site Plan (13 copies) to be submitted to the Office of the County Engineer along with drainage calculations and fees.**
